This 4-year Scholarship for the Bachelor's Degree in Computer Information Systems is being made available through a partnership between the Governor-General's Programme for Excellence "I Believe Initiative" (IBI) and Monroe College (New York).

About the I Believe Initiative (IBI)

The IBI is an arm of the Governor-General's Programme for Excellence (GGPE). Its mission is to recognize and promote excellence and empower Jamaicans to believe in themselves and achieve their God-given potential while contributing to nation building. The Initiative is driven by its mantra: "using what is right with Jamaica to fix what is wrong with Jamaica.". It was launched at King's House, Jamaica in 2011.

About Monroe College

Founded in 1933, New York-based Monroe College is a nationally ranked private institution of higher learning focused on delivering a practical, highly personalized and cross-cultural educational experience to students from over 70 countries. Monroe College offers qualified students an opportunity to pursue a degree at the undergraduate and graduate level through its Schools of Criminal Justice, Information Technology, Nursing, Education, Business & Accounting, Hospitality Management and Culinary Arts, Allied Health Professions and the King Graduate School. IBI Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

Having satisfied the application requirements to Monroe College, all candidates must submit the following to the "I Believe Initiative", King's House, May 26, 2017:

1. Completed IBI Scholarship Application Form
2. An essay describing the candidate's educational or career goals as well as any special considerations which make the candidate suitable consideration which make the candidate especially suitable for the IBI Monroe College Scholarship.
3. Certified High School transcripts.
4. Certified copy of CSEC/CAPE results. Qualified candidates would have earned seven (7) high-level CSEC passes (i.e. Grades I, II, III) and three (3) high-level CAPE passes (i.e. Grades I, II, III).
5. Two (2) letters of recommendation. (One must be from the principal of the candidate's school)

Additionally, all candidates must complete an interview with a Monroe College admissions counselor via phone or Skype. The successful candidate will be required to serve in Jamaica for a minimum of three (3) years after conferment of the degree.
