OVERVIEW

Do you know someone who has made significant impact within their community locally and has excelled academically despite their humble beginnings? If this person is a citizen of Jamaica and has never received a National Award, you could nominate him or her for special recognition by His Excellency The Governor-General of Jamaica.

The Governor-General's Achievement Awards scheme has been in existence since 1991. It was set up under the distinguished patronage of then Governor-General the Most Honourable Sir Howard Cooke, ON, GCMG, GCVO, CD with the financial support of the Building Societies and The Gleaner Company Limited, the Custodes, as well as representatives from the Jamaica Teachers' Association and Legal, Business, Community and Religious Organizations.

The Programme got off to a national start under the leadership of the Custodes in the various parishes where committees were formed to promote, distribute, receive and assess nominations from the public.

In 2007, then Governor-General, His Excellency the Most Honourable Professor Sir Kenneth O. Hall, ON, OJ, expanded the Programme to recognize *academic excellence along with volunteerism* among persons in the 18-24 years and 25-35 years age categories.

Under the leadership of current Governor-General, His Excellency the Most Honourable Sir Patrick Allen ON, GCMG, CD, KSt.J, the Governor-General's Achievement Awards programme continues to be recognized as one of Jamaica's most successful and prestigious.

NOMINATION

In order to nominate a candidate, you, the Nominator, must complete Pages two (2) and three (3) of this document. The candidate or Nominee will be required to complete a Personal Information Form and provide specific documentation to validate the information included on the form.

All documents (the Nominator's and the Nominee's) must be submitted to the Office of the Custos in the Parish where the candidate or Nominee resides. Contact information for Custodes is accessible via the internet at www.ggpe.org.jm/custodes.

DEADLINE

All required documents for persons within the 18 to 24 and 25 to 35 age categories must be submitted online at www.ggpe.org.jm/nomination and for the over 35 age category must be submitted to the Office of the Custos.

Application deadline is Monday, [March 16, 2020](#). Incomplete submissions by the deadline will not be allowed.
